### NAPLAN Results 2018

Please be aware that all families with students in Years 3, 5 and 7 should receive their child's NAPLAN report by the end of this term. This will occur once we have undertaken a review of school, cohort and student's reports. The delay in releasing these reports is due to recent concerns about the validity of comparisons/results being raised and reported in the media. It is hoped that we will receive our initial reports during this week. Individual student NAPLAN reports will be posted to ensure that it is delivered directly to parents. If you don't receive your child's results please contact the school. If you would like to discuss your child's NAPLAN report at the start of Term 4, please don't hesitate to arrange a time to meet with your child's teacher/s.

### NAPLAN Online Trials

As a site we were pleased with our recent NAPLAN online trials. We found that students interacted well with the assessment. We also found that we have suitable ICT capacity to effectively deliver the NAPLAN online tests from 2019.

### PAT (Progressive Achievement Tests) Testing Years 3 – 7

Please be aware that students in Year 3 – 7 will be undertaking Department for Education annual PAT testing from the start of Week 8 until the end of term in Reading and Maths. These results are used to directly inform learning for each student. As a site we use this information to also triangulate other internal assessments and NAPLAN results to meet the learning needs of each child.


Eight students competed in the 100m finals.

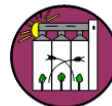
