It is hard to believe that we only have 4 school days until the end of the term. Students have worked tirelessly this term in classes to succeed and this hard work shows continuous improvement in their learning across the school.

These student leaders supported peers of all ages before and during the day with many parents providing positive feedback. Morning Drop Off or Early Arrivals

Each year with an increase in the warmer weather, some students begin to arrive at school before the bell. While we

appreciate students’ enthusiasm to get to school, we remind families that students are not to be on school grounds before 8:30am. Teachers are not on duty before this time and therefore are unable to provide a ‘duty of care’. In fact, before 8:30am staff are regularly in professional team meetings or preparing learning tasks for the day. It is important to note that while teachers are not required to open classrooms until 8:50am under their Enterprise Bargaining Agreement, we are fortunate that our teaching team continue to open their rooms from as early as 8:30am.

For yard supervision, a scheduled member of the teaching team is on duty when the 8:30am bell sounds each day. If students are at school before 8:30am they need to be supervised by a parent/caregiver.

Japanese 2019

I am delighted to announce that we have appointed a permanent Japanese teacher through the external selection process held earlier this term. Ms Melissa Amner who currently works 0.6 at Gawler Primary School will be working 0.4 at Roseworthy Primary School from the start of 2019. Melissa comes highly recommended from her current site having developed an award-winning Japanese program.

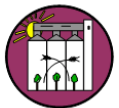
